### DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assists supervisor in planning, implementing and evaluating developmentally appropriate activities that address the social, physical, intellectual, creative and emotional needs of the child
- Assists in training and supervision of leaders, assistants and volunteers
- Assists supervisor in the day-to-day maintenance of programs
- Communicates with parents and participants
- Maintains assigned budget and petty cash
- Keeps inventory of equipment and supplies
- Facilitates program and staff evaluations

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Grade 12 plus 650+ hours of supervisor and working experience with children, or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Emergency Child Care First Aid or Standard First Aid and CPR Level B (or higher)
- Successful candidates will be required to complete a criminal record check
